Spend some time collecting visuals that represent your business "big vision" and also your ideal customers. You may find these online (Google, Pinterest, blogs, Tumblr, stock sites etc), in magazines (think about what magazines your target market might read), books, brochures, or even junk mail!

For your business vision, think back to the visualisation (read over your notes if necessary) and all the sights, smells, textures etc that came up for you.
